You will also learn various agile estimation techniques and how to estimate work using hours or story points. These skills will enable you to translate value into deliverable products and services that meet customer needs and expectations.


DELIVERING VALUE

You will explore different techniques for monitoring progress, including burndown charts, Kanban boards, and the Scrum board, and how to calculate team velocity. Moreover, you will understand how to scale Agile principles to larger, more complex projects and how to manage multiple teams.
